

Easter Story Cookies

1 cup whole pecans

1 tsp white vinegar

3 egg whites
pinch of salt

1 cup sugar
a zipper baggie
wooden spoon
your Bible

Preheat oven to 300 degrees-this is very important!

Place pecans in zipper baggie & beat them with wooden spoon to break into small pieces. Read John 19:1-3 After Jesus was arrested, He was beaten by the Roman soldiers. Smell the vinegar & read John 19:28-30. When Jesus was thirsty on the cross he was given vinegar to drink. Put vinegar in mixing bowl. Add eggs whites to vinegar. Eggs represent life. Read John10:10-11. Jesus gave His life for us! Add salt that represents the salty tears shed by Jesus' followers & the bitterness of our sins. Read Luke 23:27. Now add the cup of sugar - the sweetest part of the story is that Jesus died because He Loves us! Read Psalm 34:8 & John 3:16

Beat with mixer on high speed for 12-15 minutes until stiff peaks are formed- like the hill where He was crucified & white like the washing away of our sins. Read Isaiah 1:18 & John 3:1-3. If no allergy & if desired fold in broken nuts. Drop by teaspoon onto parchment paper covered cookie sheet. Each mound represents the rocky tomb where Jesus body was laid. Read Matthew 27:57-60. Put cookie sheet in oven, close the door like the stone was rolled to close the tomb & turn the oven OFF! Read Matthew 27:65-66. Go to Bed!

Read John 16:20 & 22 Easter Morning - open the oven - notice the cookies' cracked surface & they are hollow-just like the Tomb-Empty!!
