My gracious Redeemer, my Saviour art Thou. If ever I loved Thee, my Jesus ‘tis now.*

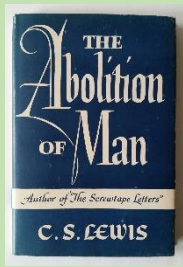

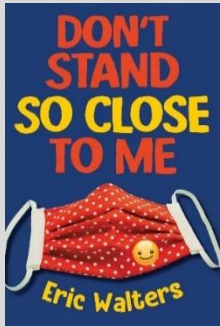
Every day, someone in our community needs our help.
