ANNUAL REPORT AND MEETING

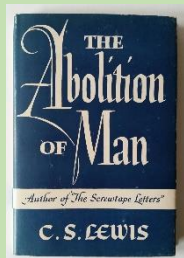


The Annual Meeting will be held this Sunday, February 20, 2022 following the worship service.
