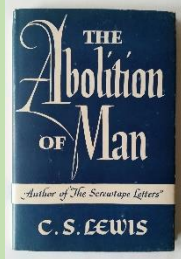

Donate to our lunch bag or grocery card program for the month of February in celebration of Mikal's birthday. How about we shoot for 50 food items and grocery store cards?



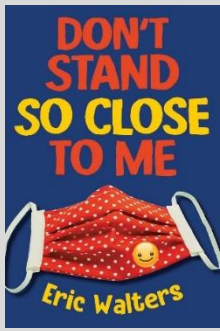
