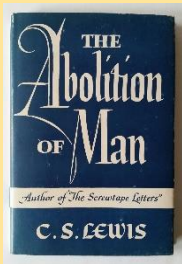


ANNUAL REPORTS

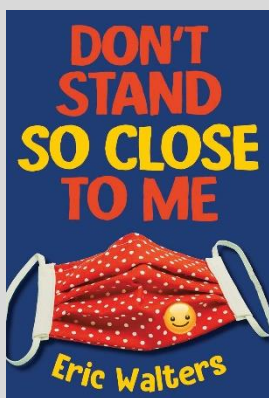
