### NORFOLK REFUGEE COMMITTEE (NRC) UPDATE

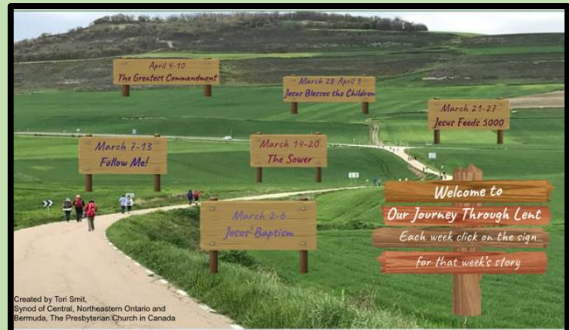
