Bring your family and friends, too.

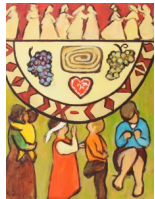
Come for the whole event if you are able, but it's ok to come for just part of the event. We will eat about 5:30 PM.
