## What does it mean to be an Elder?

You may have encountered elders

- visiting homes, hospitals, or nursing homes
- helping with worship—perhaps reading scriptures, taking up the offering, or singing in the choir
- serving communion in a church service

Sometimes someone from church may have called you, identifying herself as an elder. Perhaps someone from church has handed you the church newsletter, saying he is an elder.

From such experiences you may know that an elder is a person who

- attends church regularly
- actively serves the congregation
- is part of a larger group, the Session, which includes the minister
- is an older youth or an adult of any gender
- has gifts for leadership and ministry, including pastoral care and oversight
