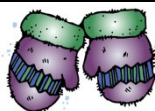
ST. PAUL'S HOLLY TEA BAZAAR

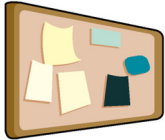
You can sing along, too! After singing, please join us for a coffee or hot chocolate in the mall café.
