THISTLE CLUB COOKBOOK UPDATE

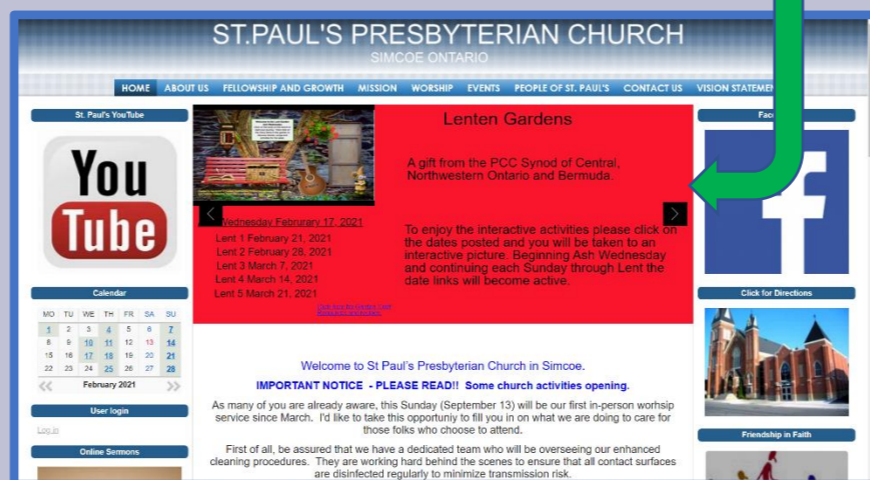
