The basket and bidding sheet are in the church lobby. Just record your name, phone # and place your bid by **August 1st** and you could be biking with these great items!

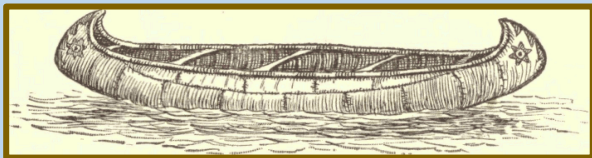
IN-PERSON WORSHIP
