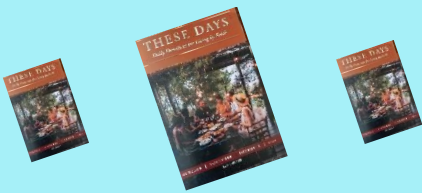
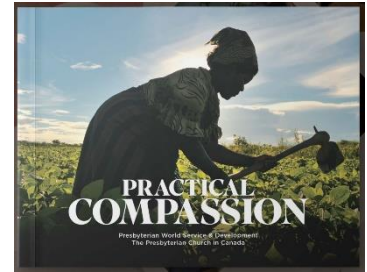


### LUNCH BUNCH – ALL ARE WELCOME!!!

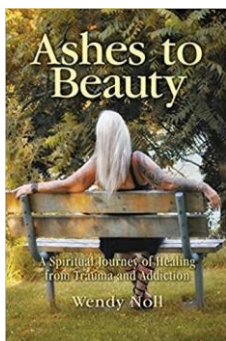

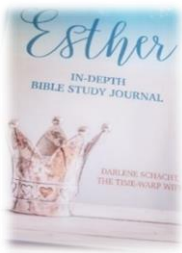
