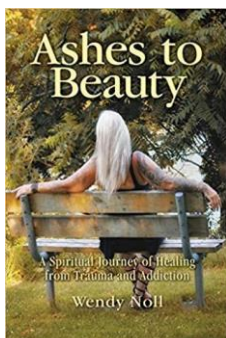
### MISSION COMMITTEE FUNDRAISER FOR PWS&D

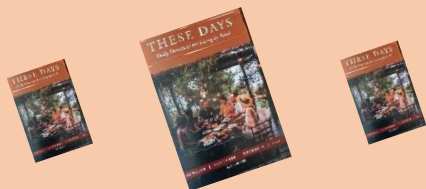

## COFFEE HOUR

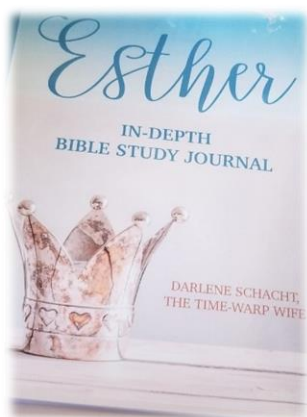
