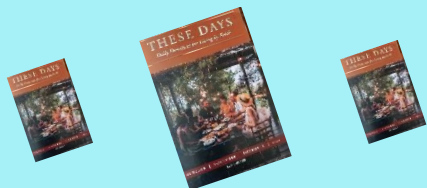
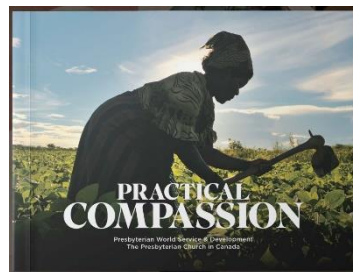


LUNCH BUNCH – ALL ARE WELCOME!!!

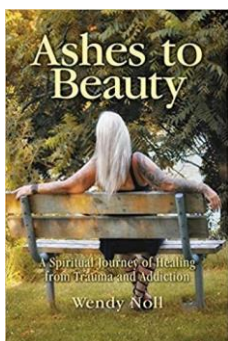

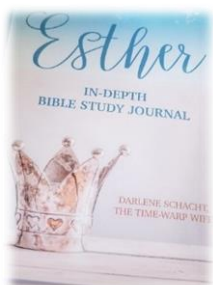

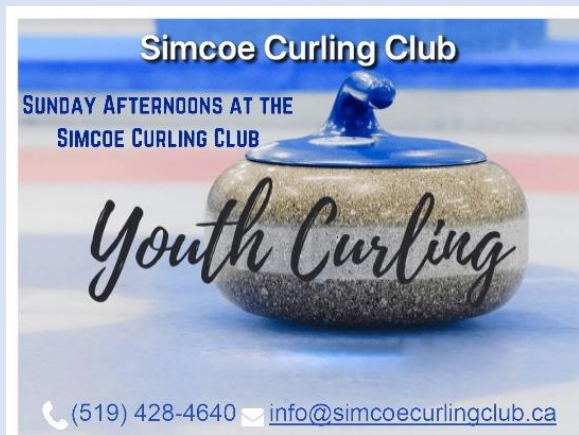
THANKSGIVING FOOD DRIVE: SUNDAY, OCTOBER 9, 2022
